Welcome and Call Meeting to Order: Stephanie called the meeting to order at 6:02pm.

2019-2020 Financial Review: Carrie went over the current financial review with those in attendance. She read of Cash Rewards and Read-a-thon overview. PTO ordered more books, Stephanie said, and had to purchase more prizes which was good because more kids were reading. Restaurant night exceeded what the board thought. Holiday Shoppe did well this year. Fifth grade celebration is going well so far. Assemblies, Authors Visit and Mother Son Bowling inflow/outflow was given by Carrie.
